- 1. FORTY-EIGHT HOURS BEFORE STARTING EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR WILL CALL J.U.L.I.E. AT 1-800-892-0123 OR 811 TO HAVE THE LOCATION OF EXISTING UTILITIES STAKED.
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON STATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT.
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT EXISTING AND NEW UTILITIES AND SHALL BRACE AND SUPPORT THE UTILITIES PROPERLY IN ORDER TO PREVENT SETTLEMENT, DISPLACEMENT, OR DAMAGE TO THE UTILITIES. THE PROTECTION OF THE UTILITIES AS SPECIFIED HEREIN WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACT UNIT PRICES.
- 4. SAW CUTTING PRIOR TO THE REMOVAL OF ANY ITEMS NOTED ON THE PLANS OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF THE ITEMS BEING REMOVED.
- 5. DO NOT SCALE PLANS FOR CONSTRUCTION DIMENSIONS.
- 6. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL USE CARE IN REMOVING OR EXCAVATING NEAR ALL EXISTING ITEMS WHICH WILL REMAIN. ANY DAMAGE DONE TO EXISTING ITEMS BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REPAIRED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.
- 7. POLLUTION CONTROL: THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH STATE REGULATIONS REGARDING AIR, WATER AND NOISE POLLUTION.
