The use of a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) for Contract 64D78 is consistent with all State and Local statutory and regulatory requirements.

Project Description: This project consists of roadway reconstruction, traffic signal modernization and intersection improvements on IL 40 From Miller Road to Linn Blvd. Also included are storm sewer, curb and gutter, concrete median, sidewalk, and a multi-use path.

Item 3:

This project includes both state and federal funding and the programmed cost for the project is \$3,300,000. Expected to be increase to \$5,300,00. Any disruption in the continuity of this project due to labor issues would result in

the delay of deadlines which would cause safety concerns for the traveling public. Lapsing trade contracts during the project duration would be addressed through use of a Project Labor Agreement. It is the Illinois Department of Transportation's finding that the large skilled workforce needed for this project can be provided by union trades involved and is a necessary requirement for a Project Labor Agreement.

Item 4:

This project is scheduled to be let in January 2022 and work is expected to begin in the spring of 2022. The project schedule indicates a 60 calendar day closure and an additional 75 working days. Any labor issues could put the project at risk of exceeding the required time frames and exposing workers and the traveling public to additional hazards.

Item 6:

The targeted completion timeframe of the contract falls beyond the union contract expiration dates noted below:

Item 8:

The proposed work will require road closures with posted detours. Redirection of traffic will cause an increase in traffic volumes on the marked detour route. Delays in work due to labor disputes would jeopardize the completion schedule for the project and unnecessarily increase the duration of construction operations in this highly traveled urbanized area.

Item 9:

The use of a PLA on this project will result in improved access to skilled labor, improved efficiency and improved safety performance because it will assist in coordinating the labor forces of twelve separate trade unions that may be involved in its construction efforts.
