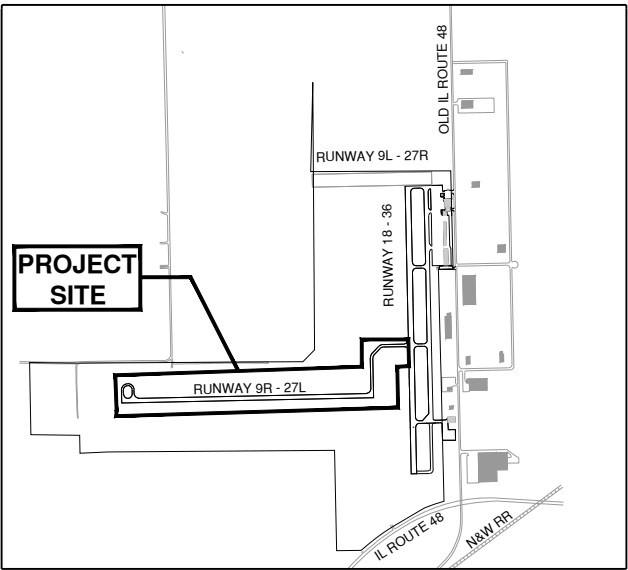

Runway 9-27 PROFILE



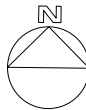

Runway 9-27 PROFILE



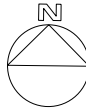
