Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 70A89 Champaign County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description: This project is for designed overlay of FAI 57 from two miles south of Thomasboro to US 136 at Rantoul in Champaign County. Other improvements associated with the project include milling, pavement patching, milled rumbles strips, guardrail removal and replacement, pavement marking, and raised reflective pavement markers.
