

SECTION A-A EXISTING AGGREGATE OR SEALCOAT SIDEROAD

SPECIAL NOTES

- The mainline pavement cross-slope is 1.5% for tangent alignment. See Plans for cross-slope on superelevated horizontal curves.
- (2) The sideroad profile should drain away from the mainline at 1% to 4% for 50' (15.0m) to 100' (30.0m), or as a minimum to the end of the radius return. When the sideroad is on the high side of a mainline superelevated curve, 2% maximum should be provided in order to minimize breakover at the pavement edge. See plans for sideroad profiles.
