BEFORE STARTING ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL "JULIE" AT 800-892-0123 FOR FIELD LOCATIONS OF BURIED ELECTRIC, TELEPHONE, AND GAS FACILITIES (48 HOURS NOTIFICATION IS REQUIRED).

THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON STATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT.

IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS EXISTING IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND ORDERING MATERIALS.

ANY REFERENCE TO STANDARDS IN THE PLANS OR SPECIAL PROVISIONS
SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO BE THE LATEST STANDARDS OF THE DEPARTMENT
LISTED IN THE PLANS WITH THE LATEST NUMBERS.

ALL DAMAGE TO EXISTING PAVENCY MADE NO OR BASED REFLECTIVE PAVENENT OUTSIDE THE REMOVAL LINE SHOWN ON THE PLANS SHALL BE REPLACED AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE DEPARTMENT.

ALL PAVEMENT PATCHING LOCATIONS WILL BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD BY THE ENGINEER.
