## CONCRETE SUPERSTRUCTURE (APROACH SLAB), SPECIAL

This work shall consist of constructing the concrete bridge approach slab in accordance with Section 503 of the Standard Specifications, as shown in the plans, and as directed by the Engineer.

Integral concrete curbs shall be according to Standard 609006 and/or as directed by the Engineer to match adjacent bridge approach pavement curb and concrete shoulder curb.

Reinforcement bars will be paid for separately, according to Article 421.04(a) of the Standard Specifications.

Protective coat will be paid for as specified in Section 420 of the Standard Specifications.

This work shall be paid for at the contract unit price per cubic yard for CONCRETE SUPERSTRUCTURE (APPROACH SLAB), SPECIAL.

## **PAVEMENT REMOVAL**

This work shall consist of the complete removal of existing pavement in accordance with Section 440 of the Standard Specifications, as shown in the plans, and as directed by the Engineer.

The removal of inlets, grates, pipes, and end sections contained within the limits and/or adjacent to pavement removal not paid for specifically in the plans shall be required.

This work shall be paid for at the contract unit price per square yard for PAVEMENT REMOVAL.

## APPORACH SLAB REMOVAL

This work shall consist of the complete removal of existing bridge approach pavements and existing timber piles, in accordance with Section 440 of the Standard Specifications, as shown in the plans, and as directed by the Engineer.

The Contractor shall remove the existing timber piles to 4" below the bottom of the approach slab.

This work shall be paid for at the contract unit price per square yard for APPROACH SLAB REMOVAL.
