#### Item 3:

This project includes both state and federal funding and the programmed cost for the project is \$5,635,000. Any disruption in the continuity of this project due to labor issues would result in the delay of deadlines which would cause safety concerns for the travelling public. Lapsing trade contracts during the project duration would be addressed through use of a Project Labor Agreement. It is the Illinois Department of Transportation's finding that the large skilled workforce needed for this project can be provided by union trades involved and is a necessary requirement for a Project Labor Agreement.

#### Item 4:

This project is scheduled to be let in November 2022 and work is expected to begin in the summer of 2022. The project schedule indicates 60 working days. Any labor issues could put the project at risk of exceeding the required timeframes and exposing workers and the travelling public to additional hazards.
