
STAGING TYPICAL SN 037-0140



THIS WORK SHALL NOT BE PAID SEPERATELY AND SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF THE "TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION STANDARD 701321 (SPECIAL)".

ALL CONFLICTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS SHALL BE PROTECTED PRIOR TO COVERING WITH PAVEMENT MARKING BLACKOUT TAPE, 4". PAVEMENT MARKING BLACKOUT TAPE, 4". Tra c signals shall be operational only when all tra c controls are in place. When tra c signals are not in operation, aggers shall be used and tra c control shall conform to Standard 701201 or 701206.

Temporary concrete barrier shall be according to Standard 704001.

Existing or temporary pavement markings shall be on both sides of open lane from stop bar to stop bar.
