The Contractor will be allowed to complete all clean-up work and punch list items within <u>10</u> guaranteed working days after the completion date for opening the roadway to traffic. Under extenuating circumstances the Engineer may direct that certain items of work, not affecting the safe opening of the roadway to traffic, may be completed within the guaranteed working days allowed

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WORKING DAYS (BDE)
