Basis of payment

This work will be paid for at the contract unit price EACH for LINE STOPS 12", which price shall include all materials,

equipment and labor necessary to perform the work as herein specified.

EXPLORATORY EXCAVATION

This work shall be done in accordance with the Standard Specifications insofar as applicable included herein and including the following description.

The work of this pay item shall consist of providing service to complete an exploratory excavation at the depth necessary to establish elevation of existing public and private utilities in the field as directed by the Engineer.

After the evaluation and size of the utility has been determined, the trench (hole) shall be backfilled with trench backfill in a manner satisfactory to the Engineer. Excavated materials shall be disposed of in accordance with Article 202 of the Standard Specifications.

This work shall be paid for at the contract unit price per FOOT for EXPLORATORY EXCAVATION.

DUST CONTROL

When ordered by the engineer, the contractor shall use the following method to allay dust and prevent a nuisance within the limits of the construction site. Dust shall be controlled by the uniform application of sprinkled water and shall be applied only when directed by the engineer, in a manner meeting his approval. Calcium chloride shall not be used for this purpose. All equipment used for this work shall meet with the engineer's approval. This work shall consist of the exclusive control of dust resulting from construction operations and is not intended for use in the compaction of earth embankments, as specified under Article 205 of the Standard Specifications. No extra compensation shall be allowed to the contractor for this work.

SOIL TESTING AND ANALYSIS

If the Contractor will be using a Clean Construction or Demolition Debris (CCDD) facility, the Village requires that a facility is selected that will accept material per the data/test results provided on the enclosed LPC 663 form.
