## GENERAL NOTES

- BEFORE STARTING ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL "JULIE" AT (800) 892-0123 OR 811 FOR FIELD LOCATIONS OF BURIED ELECTRIC, TELEPHONE, AND GAS FACILITIES. (48 HOUR NOTIFICATION REQUIRED)
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WITH UTILITY COMPANIES AND THE VILLAGE OF FOX LAKE.
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON STATE PROPERTY WITHOUT THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- 4. ANY PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS
  OBLITERATED BY MILLING AND RESURFACING OPERATIONS ON SIDE
  STREETS AND ENTRANCES SHALL BE REPLACED AND PAID FOR IN KIND.
- 5. TEN (10) FOOT TRANSITIONS SHALL BE USED TO MATCH PROPOSED CURB AND GUTTER AND MEDIAN ITEMS OF WORK TO EXISTING CURBS AND GUTTER AND MEDIANS IN THE FIELD, UNLESS OTHERWISE SHOWN. THE TRANSITIONS SHALL BE PAID FOR AT THE CONTRACT UNIT PRICE FOR THE PROPOSED ITEMS OF WORK SPECIFIED.
- 6. ALL DAMAGE TO EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS OR RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS OUTSIDE THE REMOVAL LINE SHOWN ON THE PLANS SHALL BE REPLACED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.
- 7. BEFORE BEGINNING ANY WORK, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RETAIN AND RECORD FOR FUTURE REFERENCE, ALL EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING LINES (AND RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS) IN ORDER THAT THESE LOCATIONS CAN BE RE-ESTABLISHED FOR STRIPING. EXACT LOCATIONS OF ALL PAVEMENT MARKINGS SHALL BE AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- ALL PAVEMENT PATCHING AND CURB AND GUTTER REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT LOCATIONS WILL BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD BY THE ENGINEER.
- 9. IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS EXISTING IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND ORDERING OF MATERIALS.
- O. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE DISTRICT ONE TRAFFIC CONTROL SUPERVISOR AT (847) 705-4470 A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF BEGINNING WORK.
- 11. THE RESIDENT ENGINEER SHALL CONTACT DEBBIE HANLON, AREA TRAFFIC FIELD ENGINEER, AT (847) 715-8414 A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) WEEKS PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF PERMANENT PAVEMENT MARKINGS.
- 12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO ABUTTING PROPERTY AT ALL TIMES DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT.
- 13. DO NOT SCALE PLANS FOR CONSTRUCTION DIMENSIONS.
- 14. DOUBLE LANE MARKERS ARE TO BE USED AS SHOWN ON THE DISTRICT ONE DETAIL "TYPICAL APPLICATIONS RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS (SNOW-PLOW RESISTANT)" SHOWN IN THE PLANS.
- PAVEMENT MARKING TAPE, TYPE III SHALL BE USED FOR SHORT TERM PAVEMENT MARKINGS ON ALL FINAL SURFACES. THE COST OF THE PAVEMENT MARKING TAPE, TYPE III AND ITS REMOVAL SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF SHORT TERM PAVEMENT MARKING
- 16. WHEN MILLED PAVEMENT IS OPEN TO TRAFFIC, THE MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL BETWEEN PASSES OF THE MILLING MACHINE SHALL NOT EXCEED 1 1/2 INCHES WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS 45 MPH OR LESS, AND 1 INCH WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS OVER 45 MPH.WITH WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE RESIDENT ENGINEER, A MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL OF 3 INCHES MAY BE ALLOWED IF THE EDGE OF THE MILLING IS SLOPED A MINIMUM OF 1:3 (V:H).
- 17. BUTT JOINTS WILL BE INSTALLED AT THE ENDS OF RESURFACING (WHERE RESURFACING MEETS EXISTING PAVEMENT) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE "BUTT JOINT AND HMA TAPER DETAILS" SHEET INCLUDED IN THE PLANS, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.
- 18. UNLESS OTHER CONDITIONS WARRANT EXTENDED LANE CLOSURE AS DETERMINED AND APPROVED IN WRITING BY THE ENGINEER OR AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS, OVERNIGHT CLOSURES SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED FOR REHABILITATION PROJECTS INVOLVING DAYTIME MILLING AND RESURFACING OPERATIONS AND CLASS DEACHING.
- THE CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO SAMPLE AND TEST THE UNSUITABLE MATERIAL BEING REMOVED FROM STATE PROPERTY PER ART. 669 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION. THE TESTING OF THE MATERIAL WILL BE PAID FOR PER ART. 109.04.
