THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WITH UTILITY COMPANIES AND THE CITIES OF CHICAGO, BLUE ISLAND, NAPERVILLE AND VILLAGES OF OAK BROOK, ROCKDALE & MOKENA.
