- 4. SUITABLE GRADING MATERIAL FROM ALL PORTIONS OF THE PROJECT SHALL BE USED IN FILL AREAS, AS REQUIRED, THROUGHOUT THE PROJECT.
- 5. ALL INFORMATION SHOWN ON THESE DRAWINGS RELATIVE TO EXISTING CONDITIONS IS GIVEN AS THE BEST PRESENT KNOWLEDGE, BUT WITHOUT GUARANTEE OF ACCURACY. - 2. WOODY PLANT MATERIALS WILL CONSIST OF ALL FRESH SPRING DUG MATERIALS UNLESS ITEMS ARE NOTED AS CONTAINER.
