


FLUSH PAVED MEDIAN: TWO-WAY LEFT TURN LANE WITH ONE-WAY LEFT TURN LANE AT SIGNALIZED INTERSECTION

TYPICAL PAVEMENT MARKING LEGEND


(Note: This is a District Standard Legend. Some elements may not apply to specific project.)

- (1) 100(4) Solid (Yellow)
- 2) 100(4) Solid (White)
- 3 2-150(6) Crosswalk @ 2m (6'-6")min C.-C. (White) 2-200(8) Crosswalk @ 2m (6'-6")min C.-C. (White) (When traffic signals are present.)
- 4 150(6) Skip-Dash (White)

- (5) 200(8) Solid (White)
- 300(12) Diagonal (White) (Iter(C)6 is shown on Std. 780001)
- 600(24) Stop Bar (White)
- (See Std. 780001 and Special Notes 2 & 3)
- 9 100(4) Skip-Dash (Yellow)



11) 100(4) Double Solid (Yellow)

SPECIAL NOTES

- 1. Skip-Dash markings will be centered between both ends of city blocks and shall be placed in alignment transversly across the pavement.
- 2. The following shall apply to arrows located in one-way left turn lanes:
 - A. A minimum of two (2) arrows is required. B. The maximum spacing between arrows
 - is 24 m (80').
 - C. Arrows shall be evenly spaced if three (3) or more are required.
- 3. The following shall apply to arrow pairs located in two-way left turn lanes:
 - A minimum of two (2) arrow pairs is required. The maximum spacing between arrow pairs is 61 m (200').
- Arrow pairs shall be evenly spaced if three (3) or more are required.
- The spacing between Bi Directional Left Turn Arrows is 10 m (33').

GENERAL NOTES

- 1. Refer to State Standard 780001 for additional Pavement Markings including letters & arrows.
- 2. See Plans for Pavement Markings adjacent to curbed islands and medians, and through lane

All dimensions are in millimeters (inches) unless otherwise noted.
