GENERAL NOTES

- 1. SEE CROSS SECTIONS FOR SPECIAL DITCHES AND BACK SLOPES.
- THE REMOVAL OF BITUMINOUS SURFACING NOT ON A RIGID TYPE BASE REMOVED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE BASE SHALL BE REMOVED AS EARTH EXCAVATION. THE REMOVAL OF BITUMINOUS SURFACING ON A RIGID TYPE BASE REMOVED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE BASE SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACT UNIT PRICE FOR PAVEMENT REMOVAL OF THE TYPE SPECIFIED.
- 3. THE FINAL TOP FOUR INCHES OF SOIL IN ANY RIGHT-OF-WAY AREA DISTURBED BY THE CONTRACTOR MUST BE CAPABLE OF SUPPORTING VEGETATION. THE SOIL MUST BE FROM THE A HORIZON (ZERO TO 2' DEEP) OF SOIL PROFILES OF LOCAL SOILS.

PLACEMENT AND COMPACTION OF THE BACKFILL FOR PROPOSED ACROSS ROAD CULVERTS AND EXISTING ACROSS ROAD CULVERTS THAT ARE REMOVED SHALL CONFORM TO SECTION 502.10 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, EXCEPT THAT THE MATERIAL SHALL CONFORM TO ARTICLE 208.02 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, AND SHALL BE COMPACTED TO A MINIMUM OF 95% OF THE STANDARD LABORATORY DENSITY. ANY MATERIAL CONFORMING TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF ARTICLE 1003.04 OR 1004.05 WHICH HAS BEEN EXCAVATED FROM THE TRENCHES SHALL BE USED FOR BACKFILLING THE TRENCHES. THE ENTIRE EXCAVATION, WITHIN 2 FEET OUTSIDE OF EACH SHOULDER, SHALL BE BACKFILLED WITH TRENCH BACKFILL MATERIAL TO THE BOTTOM OF THE PROPOSED SUBGRADE. IMPERIOUS MATERIAL SHALL BE USED ON THE OUTER 3 FEET AT EACH END OF THE CULVERT.
