The use of a Project Labor Agreement for this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory and regulatory requirements.

Item 3: This project includes both State and Federal funding and the programmed cost for this project is estimated at \$22,100,000.

The proposed improvements consist of bridge new deck, widening, bridge repair, scour mitigation and lighting.

Any disruption in the continuity of this project due to labor issues would result in delayed deadlines that would cause safety concerns for the traveling public in these major routes. Lapsing trade contracts during the project would be addressed using a Project Labor Agreement. It is the Illinois Department of Transportation's finding that the large skilled workforce needed for this project can be provided by the union trades involved and is a necessary requirement for a Project Labor Agreement.

Item 5:

- Anticipated Start Date for construction is April 1, 2022
- The completion date is October 1, 2023 plus 10 working days for punch list and clean-up items.

The maintenance of traffic plan has been developed in order to maintain two through lanes in southbound and one through lane northbound utilizing the southbound structure while constructing new northbound structures. Temporary pavement will be constructed during a prestage for crossovers in order to switch the northbound traffic to southbound. Temporary concrete pavement will also be utilized to provide access to MWRD maintenance facility that is located under the La Grange Road structures.
