SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," adopted January 1, 2022, the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways," and the "Manual of Test Procedures for Materials" in effect on the date of invitation for bids, and the Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions indicated on the Check Sheet included herein which apply to and govern the construction of FAP Route 17 (IL 64), Project STP-YWBI(561), Section (125,H)RS-3, DeKalb County, Contract No. 66E20 and in case of conflict with any part or parts of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

LOCATION OF PROJECT

This project is located on FAP 17 (IL 64), from Clare Road to 0.04 mile west of IL 23 (S) in Sycamore.

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

This is a 3P milling and resurfacing project. The work consists of milling at a depth of 4" and resurfacing with **2 1/2" HMA binder and 1 1/2" of HMA surface course**. There will also be construction of a retaining wall on the project. Other work will include milling and resurfacing, shoulder stone, pavement marking, guardrail, and raised reflectors.
