INCIDENTAL TAKE AUTHORIZATION

The Department is required to obtain an Incidental Take Authorization (ITA) for endangered species located in the Galena River near the proposed storm sewer outfall at STA 1194+28.1, Offset 54.9' Left. The Department must obtain this ITA prior to the Contractor initiating any work within the Galena River or within 50 ft of the proposed storm sewer discharge location. The ITA is anticipated to be obtained by the Department, no later than June 30, 2022. Once the ITA has been received by the Department, from the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR), the District's Environmental Supervisor shall notify the ENGINEER in writing that the ITA has been approved and that the CONTRACTOR is allowed to proceed with work in the Galena River. <u>Work shall not proceed within the Galena River or within 50 ft of the proposed storm sewer discharge location prior to the ENGINEER providing this written notification to the Contractor.</u> Additional commitments may be required to be implemented to comply with the ITA.
