GENERAL NOTES

- Calculated weight of Structural Steel Repair = 28,910 lbs (Grade 36) 1.
- Fasteners shall be ASTM A325 Type I, mechanically galvanized bolts, Bolts 2. 78 ℃ holes 1516 ℃ unless otherwise noted.
- No field welding is permitted except as specified in the contract documents. 3.
- The Contractor shall test the existing welds by non-destructive methods within 4 2 ft. of the existing top flange cover plates for cracks after removal of the existing concrete deck. Dye penetrant (PT), magnetic particle (MT), or other approved testing method shall be performed by qualified personnel approved by the Engineer. If cracks are found, report them to the Bureau of Bridges and Structures for disposition. The cost of testing is included in Removal of Existing Concrete Deck. The cost of crack repair, if necessary, will be paid for according to Article 109.04 of the Standard Specifications.
- 5. Reinforcement bars designated (E) shall be epoxy coated.
- 6. Prior to pouring the new concrete diaphragms and deck, all heavy or loose rust, loose mill scale, and other loose or potentially detrimental foreign material shall be removed from the surfaces in contact with concrete. Tightly adhered paint may remain unless otherwise nated. Removal shall be accomplished by methods that will not damage the steel and the cost will be included in the pay item Removal of Existing Concrete Deck.

As directed by the Engineer, the existing construction accessories welded to the top flange of beams and girders shall be removed. The weld areas shall be ground flush and inspected for cracks using magnetic particle testing (MT) or dye penetrant testing (PT) by qualified personnel approved by the Engineer. Any cracks that cannot be removed by grinding $\frac{1}{4}$ " deep shall be identified and reported to the Bureau of Bridges and Structures for further disposition. The cost of removing welded accessories, grinding and inspecting weld areas and grinding cracks will be paid for according to Article 109.04 of the Standard Specifications.

- 7. Plan dimensions and details relative to existing plans are subject to nominal construction variations. The Contractor shall field verify existing dimensions and details affecting new construction and make necessary approved adjustments prior to construction or ordering of materials. Such variations shall not be cause for additional compensation for a change in scope of the work, however, the Contractor will be paid for the quantity actually furnished at the unit price bld for the work.
- 8. Bearing seat surfaces shall be constructed or adjusted to the designated elevations within a tolerance of l_{B} " (0.01 ft.). Adjustment shall be made either by grinding the surface or by shimming the bearings.
- Cleaning and field painting of structural steel shall be done under a separate 9. paint contract except as noted.
- 10. "CLEANING AND PAINTING STRUCTURAL STEEL, LOCATION I shall be as specified in the Special Provision for "Cleaning and Painting Existing Steel Structures". The area consists of cleaning and painting the south end of beam #1 in span 5. Point limits shall be from the south end of the beam to the first splice to the north (approximately 46'). Areas to be cleaned and painted shall include the entire outer half of the beam and the bottom of the bottom flange. All steel described here shall be cleaned per commercial Grade Power tool cleaning SSPC-SP 15 and painted according to the requirements of paint system I - OZ/E/U. The color of the final finish coat for the designated area shall be gray, Munsell No. 5B 7/1."

- The existing structural steel coaling contains lead. The Contractor shall take 11 appropriate precautions to deal with the presence of lead on this project.
- All new structural steel shall be shop painted with an inorganic zinc rich primer 12. per AASHTO M300, Type I.
- Existing structural steel that will be in contact with new structural steel 13. shall be cleaned and painted as required by the Special Provision for "Cleaning and Painting Contact Surface Areas of Existing Steel Structures."
