Attachment A

Justification for use of Project Labor Agreement (PLA) on Contract 64H70, Winnebago County.

The use of PLA on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory and regulatory requirements.

Item 2: This project is federally funded

Item 3: Estimated cost is \$5,600,000

The construction progress of this project will be adversely affected due to any labor issues that may arise during construction. The scheduled road closure on both Roscoe Road legs at the intersection with IL 2 will be prolonged due to any disturbance in construction. This will increase the amount of time the traveling public will be exposed to delays in this area. It is the belief of the Department that a PLA for this project will be necessary to facilitate the completion of the project on time and avoid any delays to the motoring public.

Item 4: This project will be completed while maintaining two lanes of traffic on existing IL 2 for the most part and constructing the new pavement to the east The proposed Roscoe Road will be constructed one leg at a time utilizing lane closure for a specified amount of time.

The existing IL 2 consists of two lane roadway, and similarly for Roscoe Road. The proposed improvement will add left turn lanes at the intersection and increase the returns of the intersection to accommodate larger turning vehicles. The entire intersection will be realigned to the east to accommodate future expressway design. The existing IL 2 will then become a service drive and jurisdiction will be turned over to Rockton Township. The project is expected to be completed and opened to traffic by November 14, 2014 with 15 additional working days for landscape and punch list for the year of 2015.

- **Item 5**: The completion date for this project is on November 14, 2014 plus 15 additional working days for punch list and landscaping.
- Item 7: It is expected that without a PLA on this project, both the time table and the cost of the project will be negatively affected.
- Item 8: If any labor issues arise during construction of this project, delays may occur resulting in not meeting the completion date of the project, and also longer closures for both legs of Roscoe Road. This situation will prolong the staging sequence over winter and increase the risk of accidents and delays to motorists.
