Justification for use of Project Labor Agreement (PLA) on contract 64J29, Lee/Ogle County.

The use of a PLA on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory and regulatory requirements.

Item 2: This project is federally funded.

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Item 3: Estimated project cost is \$3,700,000 00

This project involves 13.6 miles of resurfacing along IL 251 from I-88 to Chicago Road

Any disruption in the continuity of this project due to labor issues would result in delayed deadlines that would cause safety concerns for the traveling public. Lapsing trade contracts during the first stage of the project would be addressed through the use of a PLA. It is the Illinois Department of Transportation's finding that the large skilled workforce needed for this project can be provided by the union trades involved and is a necessary requirement for a PLA.

Item 8: Any disruption to the contractor's schedule due to labor issues may result in the delay of the project working days and may result in the extension of the lane closures of the State Highway. Any delays will also increase the use of local roadway system and inconvenience to the businesses and residences along the State Highway. There will be added safety concerns for both workers and the motoring public, due to increased exposure, if labor force instability were to delay the project and increase its duration.
