## **CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS**

<u>General.</u> A concrete crack sealer shall be applied according to the manufacturer's recommendations to all cracks within the deck surface that measure 0.03 inches or greater in width at the surface as directed by the Engineer. The surface preparation, application techniques, and application rates shall be in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations. As a minimum, all concrete must be at least 14 days old, and all deck grinding, saw cut grooving, and cleanup operations must be completed. The surface shall have at least a 48-hour drying period since the last rain before application. The concrete crack sealer shall not be applied if rain is forecasted within 24 hours of the application time.

The Contractor shall provide to the Engineer written documentation from the concrete crack sealer manufacturer that outlines the recommended surface preparation, application techniques, and application rates.

<u>Basis of Payment.</u> This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per foot (ft) for BRIDGEDECK CONCRETE CRACK SEALER.
