SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, Adopted January 1, 2022", the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", and the "Manual of Test Procedures for Materials" in effect on the date of invitation for bids, and the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions" indicated on the Check Sheet included herein, which apply to and govern the construction of FAP Route 729 & FAU Route 7053 (US 136), **Project STP-8DGJ(974)**, Section 38RS-3, Vermilion County, Contract No. 70H32, and in case of conflict with any part, or parts, of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

INTENT OF PROJECT

The intent of this project is to mill and resurface the existing HMA pavement on FAP 729 / FAU 7053 (US Route 136) from 0.1 mi W of Lynch Spur in Danville to Indiana State line to extend the service life of the existing pavement and to provide a safe comfortable environment to the traveling public.

This work shall be completed utilizing lane closures in accordance with the applicable Highway Standards. Appropriate measures shall be taken by the Contractor to preserve the surrounding environment and give the maximum protection to the public while minimizing its disruption and inconvenience.

- 2. HMA Surface Course, IL 9.5, Mix "D", **N50**, 1 ¹/₂"
- 3. HMA Shoulder, 1 1/2"
- 4. HMA Surface Removal (Special) & Incidental HMA Surfacing, 1 1/2"
- 5. Aggregate Wedge Shoulders, Type B
- 6. Pavement Marking
- 7. Raised Reflective Pavement Markers
- 8. Survey Markers
- 9. All other items necessary to complete construction on FAP 729 & FAU 7053.
