The use of Project Labor Agreement (PLA) for Contract 62N33 is consistent with all State and Local statutory and regulatory requirements.

Item 3: This project includes both State and Federal funding and the programmed cost for this project is estimated at \$ 11,232,000. The scope of work consists of implementation of several ITS elements to improve local and regional mobility by addressing arterial congestion and improving transit mode share along IL Route 64 (North Avenue) from Smith/Kautz Rd to York Rd. The ITS elements include traffic signal modernization, signal timing/progress, changeable message signs, signing (new), traffic surveillance, and ADA improvements.
