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#### **GENERAL NOTES:**

- TEN (10) FOOT TRANSITIONS SHALL BE USED TO MATCH PROPOSED CURB AND CUTTER AND MEDIAN ITEMS OF WORK TO EXISTING CURBS AND GUTTER AND MEDIANS IN THE FIELD, UNLESS OTHERWISE SHOWN. THE TRANSITIONS SHALL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT THE COST SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF THE REMOVAL ITEM.
- EXCEPT AS NOTED ON THE PLANS, PAVEMENT GRADES SHOWN ARE AT THE TOP OF PAVEMENT SURFACES.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON STATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT.
- 4. ONLY THOSE TREES DESIGNATED BY THE ENGINEER, LISTED IN THE TREE REMOVAL SCHEDULE, OR SHOWN IN THE PLANS SHALL BE REMOVED. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT ALL REMAINING TREES FROM DAMAGE DUE TO HIS OPERATIONS.
- 5. THE LOCATION OF EXISTING DRAINAGE STRUCTURES, STORM SEWERS, WATER MAINS, SANITARY SEWERS, AND ANY OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE UTILITIES AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS IS APPROXIMATE, AND THEIR EXACT LOCATION SHALL BE VERIFIED BY THE CONTRACTOR AS PER ARTICLE 105.07 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS. LOCATING UTILITIES AS AUTHORIZED BY THE ENGINEER IN WRITING SHALL BE PAID PER ARTICLE 109.04.
- 6. WHEN ARTIFICIAL LIGHTING IS UTILIZED IN NIGHT OPERATIONS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXERCISE THE UTMOST PRECAUTIONS IN PREVENTING ADVERSE VISIBILITY TO THE MOTORING PUBLIC AND ADJOINING RESIDENTIAL AREAS.
- 7. THE WORK REQUIRED TO CONNECT ANY SEWER TO AN EXISTING DRAINAGE STRUCTURE OR PIPE OR IN CONFLICT WITH PROPOSED WORK WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACT UNIT PRICE BID FOR THE SEWER ITEMS.
- 8. IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS EXISTING IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND ORDERING OF MATERIALS.
- 9. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT AND CAREFULLY PRESERVE ALL SECTION OR SUBSECTION MONUMENTS, PROPERTY CORNERS, AND REFERENCE MARKERS UNTIL THE OWNER, HIS AGENT, OR ANY AUTHORIZED SURVEYOR HAS WITNESSED OR OTHERWISE REFERENCED THEIR LOCATIONS.
- 10. ABANDONED UNDERGROUND UTILITIES THAT CONFLICT WITH
  CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE DISPOSED OF OUTSIDE THE LIMITS OF THE
  RIGHT OF WAY ACCORDING TO ARTICLE 202.03 OF THE STANDARD
  SPECIFICATIONS AND AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. THIS WORK WILL
  NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE DISTRICT ONE TRAFFIC CONTROL SUPERVISOR AT (847)705-4470 A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF BEGINNING WORK.
- 12. DO NOT SCALE PLANS FOR CONSTRUCTION DIMENSIONS.

- 13. ANY REFERENCE TO A STANDARD IN THESE PLANS SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO MEAN THE EDITION AS INDICATED BY THE SUBNUMBER SHOWN IN THE LIST OF STANDARDS OR THE COPY INCLUDED IN THESE PLANS.
- 14. ALL DAMAGE TO DEPARTMENT OWNED UNDERGROUND FACILITIES, CAUSED BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REPAIRED TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE DEPARTMENT AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE. THIS SHALL INCLUDE ALL TEMPORARY REPAIRS REQUIRED TO KEEP THE FACILITY OPERATIONAL WHILE MATERIAL IS BEING OBTAINED TO MAKE PERMANENT REPAIRS, SPLICING OF ELECTRIC CABLE SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED. ELECTRIC CABLE SHALL BE REPLACED FROM POLE TO POLE OR CONTROLLER.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT JULIE AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO EXCAVATION TO DETERMINE WHICH UTILITIES ARE IN THE AREA.
- 16. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN EXISTING STREET ACCESS, AND EXISTING DRIVEWAY ACCESS TO ABUTTING PROPERTY AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT. UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED IN THE PLANS OR DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. THIS WORK WILL NOT BE PAID FOR EPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE ITEM OF TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION, (SPECIAL).
- 17. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ANY BUS STOPS ENCOUNTERED WITHIN THE PROJECT AREA WITH AT LEAST A HARD SURFACE FOR WAITING AND A PAD FOR BOARDING & ALIGNING. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CONTACTING AND COORDINATING WITH PACE AND OTHER BUS SERVICES THE MAINTENANCE OF THE BUS STOPS ALONG THE CONSTRUCTION ROUTE. THIS WORK WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT THE COSTS SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS INCIDENTAL TO TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION, AND NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION WILL BE ALLOWED.
- 18. SAWING OF REMOVAL ITEMS AS NOTED ON THE PLANS, SPECIFIED IN THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, OR AS REQUIRED BY THE ENGINEER SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF THE ITEM BEING REMOVED
- 19. IT IS THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ASCERTAIN EXISTING FIELD CONDITIONS BEFORE BIDDING ON THIS CONTRACT
- 20. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE ALL NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS FOR THE PROTECTION OF EXISTING PLANT MATERIAL FOR WHICH THE CONTRACT DOES NOT PROVIDE REMOVAL. THE PROTECTION OF EXISTING PLANT MATERIAL AND THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING PLANT MATERIAL DAMAGED BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 201 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- THE RESIDENT ENGINEER SHALL CONTACT MS. PATRICE HARRIS, AREA TRAFFIC FIELD TECHNICIAN, AT 708-597-9800 A MINIMUM OF TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF FINAL PAVEMENT MARKINGS.
- 22. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL DETERMINE WHEN FLAT SLAB TOPS ARE REQUIRED ON MANHOLES AND CATCH BASINS. NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION SHALL BE ALLOWED FOR THE USE OF FLAT SLAB TOPS.
