GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. ALL PROPOSED LIGHTING UNITS SHALL BE LABELED ACCORDING TO THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, WITH POLE NUMBERS ATTACHED WITH STAINLESS STEEL BANDING. LIGHTING UNIT NUMBERING SHALL BE AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 2. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO COORDINATE ELECTRICAL WORK WITH OTHER TRADES.
- 3. LIGHT POLE FOUNDATIONS SHALL BE INSTALLED PLUMB AND FLUSH WITH THE PROPOSED GRADE AND SHALL MEET THE HEIGHT REQUIREMENTS OF ARTICLE 836.03 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS. AFTER UNIT DUCT IS INSTALLED, FOUNDATIONS SHALL BE FILLED WITH FINE AGGREGATE ACCORDING TO ARTICLE 836.03. WASHERS USED TO INSTALL THE POLE SHALL BE LARGE ENOUGH TO FULLY COVER THE SLOTTED HOLES IN THE POLE BASE PLATE.
- 4. CONTRACTOR SHALL INSTALL LIGHT POLES AT THE LOCATIONS INDICATED ON THE PLANS, MAINTAINING ADEQUATE CLEARANCE FROM UTILITY LINES. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO VERIFY CLEARANCES PER THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL SAFETY CODE AND/OR THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE UTILITY COMPANIES. THE LOCATION OF BURIED AND ABOVE GROUND UTILITIES SHOWN ARE APPROXIMATE AND ARE SHOWN FOR INFORMATION ONLY. REROUTING, DISCONNECTION, RELOCATION, PROTECTION ETC., OF ANY UTILITIES MUST BE COORDINATED BETWEEN THE CONTRACTOR, UTILITY COMPANY, AND OWNER. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE EXACT LOCATION OF ALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR UNCOVERING OR HAND DIGGING AROUND UTILITIES AS NECESSARY. THE COST OF THIS WORK IS TO BE INCLUDED WITH THE "UNDERGROUND CONDUIT, COILABLE NONMETALLIC CONDUIT, 2 1/2" DIA." AND "UNIT DUCT, 600V, 2-1C NO.8, 1/C NO.8 GROUND, (XLP-TYPE USE), 3/4" DIA. POLYETHYLENE" PAY ITEMS.
- 6. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND INSTALL A CONCRETE WORK PAD IN FRONT OF THE LIGHTING CONTROLLER PER SECTION 825 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- 7. INSTALL HORIZONTAL MOUNT LUMINAIRES PERPENDICULAR TO THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROADWAY AS REQUIRED BY ARTICLE 821.04 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- 8. UNDERGROUND CONDUIT, COILABLE NONMETALLIC CONDUIT, 2 1/2" DIA. SHALL BE SCHEDULE 80 AS NOTED IN THE PLANS.

COMMITMENTS:

1. THE FIELD/RESIDENT ENGINEER SHALL CONTACT STUDIES AND PLANS COVERING ANY MAJOR PLAN CHANGES TO MAKE SURE NO PREVIOUS COMMITMENTS (NOT LISTED) WERE MADE AFFECTING THE DESIGN, AND TO ALLOW IMPROVED DESIGN FOR THE FUTURE.

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
