

REMOVAL OF DAMAGED MATERIALS SHALL INCLUDE DISMANTLING, LOADING, HAULING, AND DISPOSAL.

THE WORK SITE SHALL BE LEFT IN A SAFE AND ORDERLY CONDITION.

NO MATERIAL SHOULD BE LEFT ON OR NEAR THE ROADWAY.

ALL EXCAVATED MATERIAL, WHICH INCLUDED DIGGING OR GRADING OF ANY SOIL OR FILL MATERIAL, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF AGGREGATE FILLS, MUST BE INCORPORATED WITHIN, THE IDOT RIGHT OF WAY DUE TO ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS.

ANY WORK ORDER MAY BE CANCELLED AT THE ENGINEERS DISCRETION.

NO OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES WILL BE ALLOWED.

ANY REFERENCE TO A STANDARD IN THESE PLANS SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO MEAN THE EDITION AS INDICATED BY THE SUBNUMBER SHOWN IN THE LIST OF STANDARDS OR THE COPY INCLUDED IN THESE PLANS.

THE CONTRACTOR IS ADVISED THAT THERE MAY BE PRESENCE OF DEPARTMENT OWNED UNDERGROUND ELECTRICAL CABLE WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REQUEST THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN OTTAWA (815-434-8505) TO LOCATE THE UNDERGROUND FACILITIES, PROVIDING A MINIMUM 72 HOURS NOTICE. ELECTRIC CABLE SHALL BE REPLACED FROM POLE TO POLE OR CONTROLLER.
