Compliance with this Special Provision shall be included in the cost of the contract and no additional compensation will be allowed for any costs incurred.

EMERGENCY SERVICES COORDINATION

This contract work is within the corporate boundaries of the City of Granite City and includes work directly related to streets and roads. This work may compromise regular traffic flow.

Any time normal traffic flow is to be interrupted, however briefly, the City of Granite City Fire Department and the City of Granite City Police Department must be advised. This is especially necessary when any street or road is completely impassable.

When the above scenario presents itself, contact the fire department at (618) 876-4546, the police department at (618) 876-9027, and the sheriff department at (618) 692-6087 to relay this information.

Madison County Transit routes run through the construction area. Any time normal bus traffic flow is interrupted or affected, they must be contacted at (618) 797-4600 so they can be advised and plan accordingly.

COMPLETION DATE

The Contractor shall complete all contract items and safely open all roadways to vehicular and pedestrian traffic by 11:59 p.m. on <u>7/31/2019</u>.
