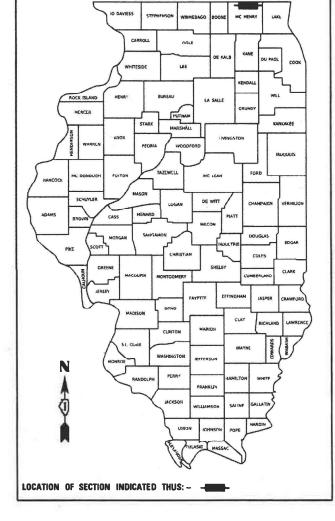

ALL CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION ADOPTED JANUARY 1, 2022 HEREIN AFTER REFERRED TO AS THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, THE SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATIONS AND RECURRING SPECIAL PROVISIONS ADOPTED JANUARY 1, 2024, THE LATEST EDITION OF THE ILLINOIS MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES FOR STREETS AND HIGHWAYS, THE DETAILS IN THE PLANS, AND THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.
- 2. BEFORE STARTING ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL "J.U.L.I.E." AT (800) 892-0123 OR 811 FOR FIELD LOCATIONS OF BURIED UTILITY FACILITIES. 48 HOUR NOTICE IS REQUIRED.
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WITH UTILITY COMPANIES AND THE VILLAGE OF SPRING GROVE AND THE CITY OF RICHMOND.
- 4. THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON STATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE DISTRICT ONE TRAFFIC CONTROL SUPERVISOR KALPANA KANNAN-HOSADURGA, AT KALPANA.KANNAN-HOSADURGA@ILLINOIS.GOV A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF BEGINNING WORK AND INSTALLATION.
- 6. THE RESIDENT ENGINEER SHALL CONTACT THE TRAFFIC FIELD AREA ENGINEER FADI SULTAN, AT FADI.SULTAN.GOV A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) WEEKS PRIOR TO THE PLACEMENT OF PERMANENT PLACEMENT MARKINGS.
- DO NOT SCALE PLANS FOR CONSTRUCTION DIMENSIONS.
- 3. WHEN MILLED PAVEMENT IS OPEN TO TRAFFIC, THE MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL BETWEEN PASSES OF THE MILLING MACHINE SHALL NOT EXCEED 1½ INCHES. A MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL OF 3 INCHES MAY BE ALLOWED IF THE EDGE OF THE MILLING IS SLOPED AT A MINIMUM OF 1:3 (V:H).
- 9. BUTT JOINTS SHALL BE INSTALLED AT THE ENDS OF ALL RESURFACING (WHERE RESURFACING MEETS EXISTING PAVEMENT) ACCORDING TO THE "BD-32 BUTT JOINT AND HOT-MIX ASPHALT TAPER DETAILS" SHEET INCLUDED IN THE PLANS, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.
- 10. UNLESS OTHER CONDITIONS WARRANT EXTENDED LANE CLOSURE AS DETERMINED AND APPROVED IN WRITING BY THE ENGINEER OR AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS, OVERNIGHT CLOSURES SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED FOR REHABILITATION PROJECTS INVOLVING DAYTIME MILLING, RESURFACING, AND CLASS C AND D PATCHING OPERATIONS.
- 11. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXERCISE CAUTION WHEN REMOVING OR EXCAVATING NEAR ALL EXISTING ITEMS WHICH WILL REMAIN. ANY DAMAGE DONE TO EXISTING ITEMS BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REPAIRED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.
- 12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ACCESS TO ABUTTING PROPERTIES AT ALL TIMES DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT.
- 13. THE LOCATION OF EXISTING DRAINAGE STRUCTURES, STORM SEWERS, WATER MAINS, SANITARY SEWERS, AND ANY OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE UTILITIES AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS IS APPROXIMATE AND THEIR EXACT LOCATION IS TO BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD BY THE CONTRACTOR.
- 14. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROTECTION OF ALL UNDERGROUND AND SURFACE UTILITIES EVEN THOUGH THEY MIGHT NOT BE SHOWN IN THE PLANS. ANY UTILITY PROPERTY DAMAGED DURING CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE REPAIRED OR REPLACED TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE ENGINEER.
- 15. ANY LOOSE MATERIAL DEPOSITED IN THE FLOW LINE OF DRAINAGE STRUCTURES WHICH OBSTRUCTS THE NATURAL FLOW OF WATER SHALL BE REMOVED AT THE CLOSE OF EACH WORKING DAY. PRIOR TO ACCEPTANCE OF THE IMPROVEMENT, ALL DRAINAGE STRUCTURES SHALL BE FREE OF DIRT AND DEBRIS. THIS WORK WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS INCLUDED IN THE UNIT BID PRICES OF THE CONTRACT.
- 16. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN PEDESTRIAN ACCESS AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION.
- 17. IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS EXISTING IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND ORDERING OF MATERIALS.
- 18. EXACT LOCATIONS OF PAVEMENT PATCHING AND CURB & GUTTER REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT WILL BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD BY THE ENGINEER.
- 19. ALL PAVEMENT MARKINGS SHALL BE PLACED THROUGHOUT THE IMPROVEMENT ACCORDING TO THE DISTRICT 1 TYPICAL PAVEMENT MARKING STANDARD DETAIL.
- 20. ALL DAMAGE TO EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS OR RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS OUTSIDE THE REMOVAL LINE SHOWN ON THE PLANS SHALL BE REPLACED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.
- 21. PAVEMENT MARKING TAPE, TYPE III SHALL BE USED FOR SHORT TERM PAVEMENT MARKINGS ON ALL FINAL SURFACES.
- 22. 2-FOOT TRANSITIONS SHALL BE USED TO MATCH PROPOSED CURB AND GUTTER ITEMS OR WORK TO EXISTING CURBS AND GUTTERS UNLESS OTHERWISE SHOWN. THE TRANSITIONS SHALL BE PAID FOR AT THE CONTRACT UNIT PRICE FOR THE PROPOSED ITEMS OF WORK.
- 23. SAW CUTTING OF SIDEWALK, CURB & GUTTER, ETC. SHALL BE TO FULL DEPTH AND SHALL RESULT IN A CLEAN STRAIGHT EDGE ON THE PORTION REMAINING. ALL SAW CUTTING SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCLUDED IN THE COST OF THE ITEM REMOVED.
- 24. ADJUSTMENT OF PRIVATE UTILITIES WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE IMPROVEMENTS SHALL BE PERFORMED BY THEIR RESPECTIVE OWNERS AND ARE NOT PART OF THIS CONTRACT.
- 25. DRAINAGE ADJUSTMENT OR RECONSTRUCTION LOCATIONS WILL BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD BY THE ENGINEER.
- 26. ANY DETECTOR LOOPS DAMAGED OUTSIDE OF THE RESURFACING LIMITS SHALL BE REPLACED BY THE CONTRACTOR AT NO EXPENSE TO THE DEPARTMENT.
- 27. BEFORE BEGINNING ANY WORK, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RETAIN AND RECORD FOR FUTURE REFERENCE, ALL EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING LINES (AND RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS) IN ORDER THAT THESE LOCATIONS CAN BE RE-ESTABLISHED FOR STRIPING. EXACT LOCATIONS OF ALL PAVEMENT MARKINGS SHALL BE AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 28. ALL MILLED SURFACES SHALL BE AT A UNIFORM CROSS SLOPE PER LANE AND FREE OF RIDGES BETWEEN PASSES. ANY DEVIATIONS SHALL BE CORRECTED AT NO COST TO THE DEPARTMENT.
- 29. DIMENSIONS ALONG SIDE STREET ARE FROM THE EDGE OF PAVEMENT LINE ON US 12.
- 30. FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTIMATING PLAN QUANTITIES 2.06 TONS PER CUBIC YARD WAS USED FOR AGGREGATE SHOULDER AND AGGREGATE WEDGE SHOULDER. THIS RATE SHALL NOT BE USED FOR THE BASIS OF FINAL QUANTITIES.
- 31. EXISTING BROKEN FRAMES AND LIDS SHALL BE REMOVED AND DISPOSED OF BY THE CONTRACTOR AND SHALL BE REPLACED AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. REPLACEMENT FRAMES AND LIDS WILL BE PAID FOR ACCORDING TO ARTICLE 109.04 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS UNLESS A SEPARATE PAY ITEM HAS BEEN PROVIDED.
- 32. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO KEEP A RECORD OF THE LOCATIONS OF PLATED STRUCTURES BY STATION AND OFFSET LEFT OR RIGHT OF THE CENTERLINE OF PAVEMENT.

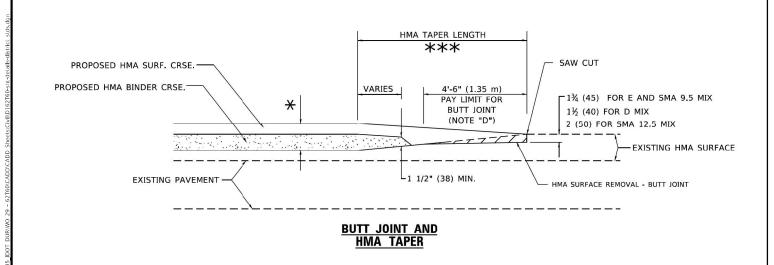


HMA CONSTRUCTED TEMPORARY RAMP

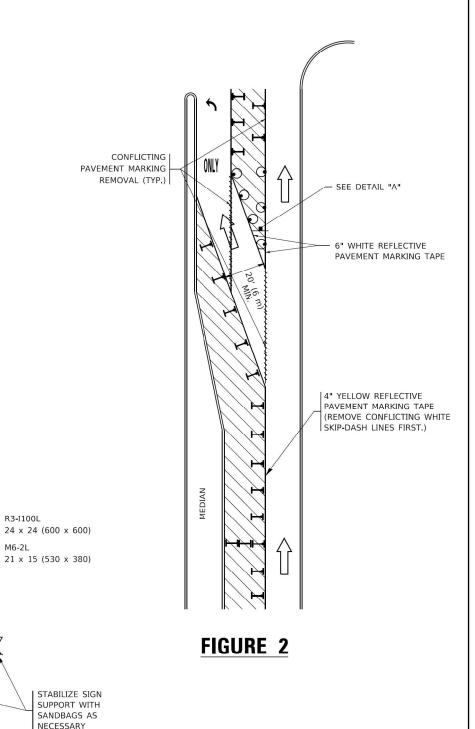

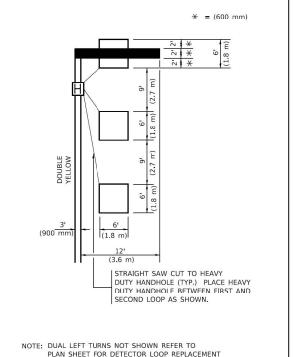

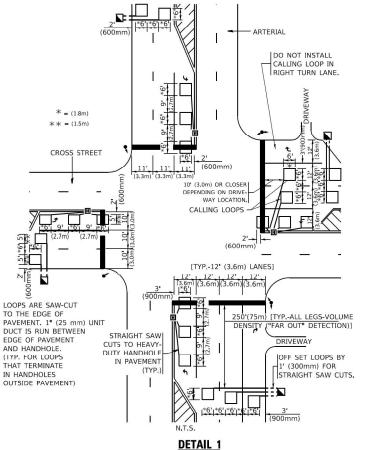

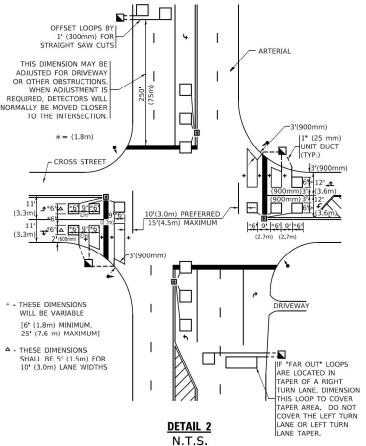
