

NOTES:

CONCRETE BASE AND BLOCKING MATERIAL SHALL NOT BLOCK NOR OBSTRUCT HYDRANT DRAIN

ALL BLOCKS BEAR AGAINST UNDISTURBED EARTH.

ALL BLOCKS SHALL BE MINIMUM 3000 PSI CONCRETE.

ALL FIRE HYDRANTS SHALL HAVE A FIVE AND ONE QUARTER INCH (51/4") MAIN VALVE OPENING.

HYDRANT COLOR SHALL BE YELLOW.

HYDRANT SHALL HAVE TWO (2) TWO AND ONE HALF INCH (21/2") HOSE CONNECTIONS AND ONE (1) FOUR AND ONE HALF INCH $(4\frac{1}{2})$ CONNECTION.

THREADS SHALL BE NATIONAL STANDARD.

THE HYDRANT SHALL HAVE A BREAKAWAY TRAFFIC FLANGE AND CONNECTIONS.

HYDRANT SHOES SHALL BE SIX INCH (6") MECHANICAL JOINTS WITH MEGA-LUG RETAINER GLANDS.

HYDRANT LEADS MAY BE SIX INCH (6") SWIVEL ANCHORING COUPLING. HYDRANT TEES SHALL BE USED IN LIEU OF SWIVEL ANCHORING COUPLING PIPE IF NECESSARY.
