

ANY DAMAGE TO THE UNDERGROUND FACILITIES, CAUSED BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REPAIRED TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE DEPARTMENT AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE, INCLUDING TEMPORARY REPAIRS WHICH MAY BE REQUIRED TO KEEP THE FACILITY OPERATIONAL WHILE MATERIAL IS BEING OBTAINED TO MAKE PERMANENT REPAIRS.
- 2. THE LOCATIONS OF THOSE BURIED AND ABOVEGROUND UTILITIES SHOWN ARE APPROXIMATE, ARE SHOWN FOR CONTRACTOR INFORMATIONAL USE ONLY, AND ARE NOT TO BE REFERENCED FOR CONSTRUCTIONS PURPOSES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT AND CAREFULLY PRESERVE ALL MONUMENTS UNTIL AN AUTHORIZED SURVEYOR OR AGENT HAS WITNESSED OR OTHERWISE REFERENCED THEIR LOCATION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR HAVING AN AUTHORIZED SURVEYOR RE-ESTABLISH ANY SECTION OR SUBSECTION MONUMENTS DESTROYED BY HIS OPERATIONS.
- 10. THERE IS ONE RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKER WITHIN THE RESURFACING LIMITS.
 THE COST OF REMOVING THE RPM SHALL NOT BE PAID SEPARATELY BUT INCLUDED IN THE COST OF THE ASSOCIATED PAY ITEMS.

- 1. CLOSE THE DRIVING LANE USING STANDARD 701406.
- 2. MILL THE DRIVING LANE AND OUTSIDE SHOULDER.
- 3. COVER THE INLET WITH PLYWOOD, STEEL PLATE, OR SIMILAR.
- 4. PAVE THE DRIVING LANE AND OUTSIDE SHOULDER PAVING OVER BOTH THE EXPANSION JOINT AND INLETS.
- 5. MOVE LANE CLOSURE TO PASSING LANE USING STANDARD 701406.
- 6. MILL THA PASSING LANE AND INSIDE SHOULDER.
- 7. COVER THE INLET WITH PLYWOOD, STEEL PLATE, OR SIMILAR.
- 8. PAVE THE PASSING LANE AND INSIDE SHOULDER PAVING OVER BOTH THE EXPANSION JOINT AND INLETS.
- . CLOSE THE DRIVING LANE USING STANDARD 701406.
- 10. SAW CUT THE HMA SURFACE AT THE OUTSIDE INLET. REMOVE THE HMA SURFACE AT THE INLET. REMOVE
 THE CASTING AND GRATE BY CHIPPING OUT THE CONCRETE AROUND THE CASTING. FORM THE INLET TO
 THE PROPOSED ELEVATION.
- 11. SAW CUT THE HMA SURFACE FOR THE POLYMER CONCRETE EXPANSION JOINT IN THE DRIVING LANE AND OUTSIDE SHOULDER. REMOVE THE HMA SURFACE AT THE EXPANSION JOINT.
- 12. POUR THE POLYMER CONCRETE AT THE DRIVING LANE EXPANSION JOINT AND OUTSIDE INLET. PLACE THE SILICONE JOINT SEALER AFTER POLYMER CONCRETE SETS UP.
- 13. CLOSE THE PASSING LANE USING STANDARD 701406.
- 14. SAW CUT THE HMA SURFACE AT THE INSIDE INLET. REMOVE THE HMA SURFACE AT THE INLET. REMOVE
 THE CASTING AND GRATE BY CHIPPING OUT THE CONCRETE AROUND THE CASTING. FORM THE INLET TO
 THE PROPOSED ELEVATION.
- 15. SAW CUT THE HMA SURFACE FOR THE POLYMER CONCRETE EXPANSION JOINT IN THE PASSING LANE AND OUTSIDE SHOULDER. REMOVE THE HMA SURFACE AT THE EXPANSION JOINT.
- 16. POUR THE POLYMER CONCRETE AT THE PASSING LANE EXPANSION JOINT AND OUTSIDE INLET. PLACE THE SILICONE JOINT SEALER AFTER POLYMER CONCRETE SETS UP.




