The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, adopted January 1, 2022", the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", and the "Manual of Test Procedures for Materials" in effect on the date of invitation for bids, and the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions" indicated on the Check Sheet included herein, which apply to and govern the construction of FAP Route 301 (US 20), Project NHPP-25G6(672), Section (3,4)RS-2, Winnebago County, Contract No. #64M40 and in case of conflict with any part, or parts, of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

### LOCATION OF PROJECT

US 20 from the Rock River to 0.7 mile west of Alpine Road.

### **DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT**

Cold milling and hot-mix asphalt resurfacing on US 20 from the Rock River to 0.7 mile west of Alpine Road in Rockford. Scope includes guardrail improvements, ramp resurfacing, and US 20/IL 251 lighting updates.
