Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 70D64 McLean County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

**Project Description:** The intent of this project is to perform Bridge Deck Repairs and other repairs to S.N. 057-0152 and S.N. 057-0153 carrying I-55 over US 24 0.44 miles west of Old 66; to S.N. 057-0173 & S.N. 057-0174 carrying I-55 over Turkey Creek 2.6 miles north of Lexington; to S.N. 057-0178 & S.N. 057-0179 carrying I-55 over the A.T. & S.F. Railroad 0.25 miles north of US 24; to S.N. 057-0182 & S.N. 057-0183 carrying I-55 over Turkey Creek 1.25 miles northwest of Lexington in order to improve the ride and extend the service life of the existing bridge decks. Other items of work include raising approach slabs as needed, substructure repair, pavement markings, raised reflective pavement marker replacement, and HMA shoulder replacement.
