proposed work. Any cable or conduit which is damaged as a result of the Contractor's operations shall be replaced by him at his expense. Replacement material and methods shall meet or exceed the original specifications for the wiring. Splicing will not be permitted.

## TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

Effective 1985 Revised 12/11/19

During the entire construction period, the road shall be kept open to traffic as follows:

- (a) The highway shall be kept open to at least one lane of traffic at all times, and to two lanes of traffic to the greatest extent possible.
- (b) Access to all public roads and private entrances shall be maintained during all stages of the work.

Prior to allowing traffic on any portion of the roadway that has been cold milled, the Contractor shall have erected "Rough Grooved Surface" and "Uneven Pavement" signs that conform to the details shown in the plans. A minimum of one sign at each end of the improvement will be required. The Contractor shall maintain the "Rough Grooved Surface" signs until the cold milled surface is covered with leveling binder. The Contractor shall maintain the "Uneven Pavement" signs until the resurfacing operations are completed. The cost of furnishing, erecting, maintaining, and removing the required signs shall be incidental to the contract.

All ADA ramps shall be constructed prior to milling and resurfacing.

## **PAVEMENT PATCHING**

Work shall be done in accordance with Sections 440 and 442.

When Class C Patches are located in areas of existing brick pavement, a diamond blade wheel saw shall be required to limit spalling of the existing brick pavement. This work will not be paid for separately, but shall be considered included in the contract unit prices of the type and size of patches involved.

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## HMA SURFACE REMOVAL

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Due to the varing depths of HMA, any increase or decrease in the thickness of HMA removal shall be included in the contract unit price of HMA SURFACE REMOVAL 3 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>". HMA shall be removed to bare brick.
