Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 74945 Clark County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description: This project is for the rehabilitation of FAP 832(IL 49) from Coles County line to 0.3 mi north of I-70. Other improvements associated with the project include paving, patching, milling, traffic control and pavement marking.

- Item 3: Estimated project cost is \$6,370,000. The use of a PLA will assure the project will be completed efficiently.
- Item 4: Estimated working days for this project is 120. The use of a PLA will assure labor force continuity and stability over the length of the project.
- Item 8: Any disruption to the contractor's schedule due to labor issues may result in an increase in duration of the project. This, in turn, would increase the length of time the traffic control on III 49 will be in place. The district desires to minimize the length of time traffic control is on roadway to reduce the potential for crashes and improve safety.
