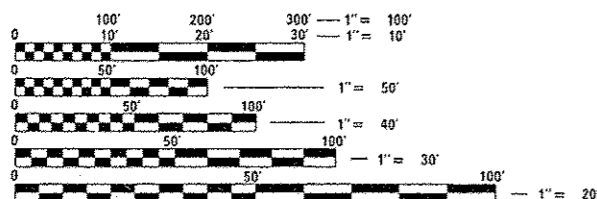
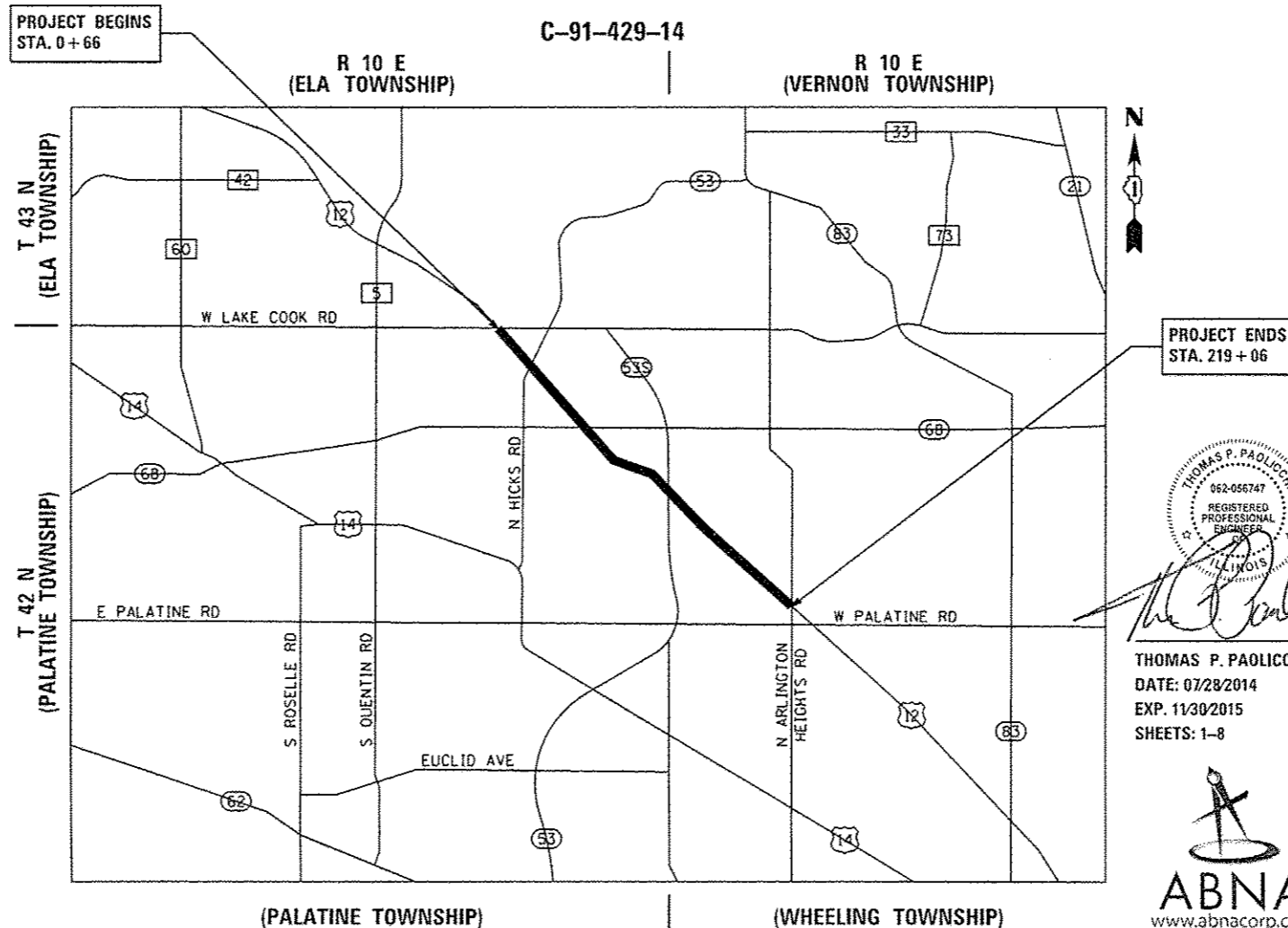
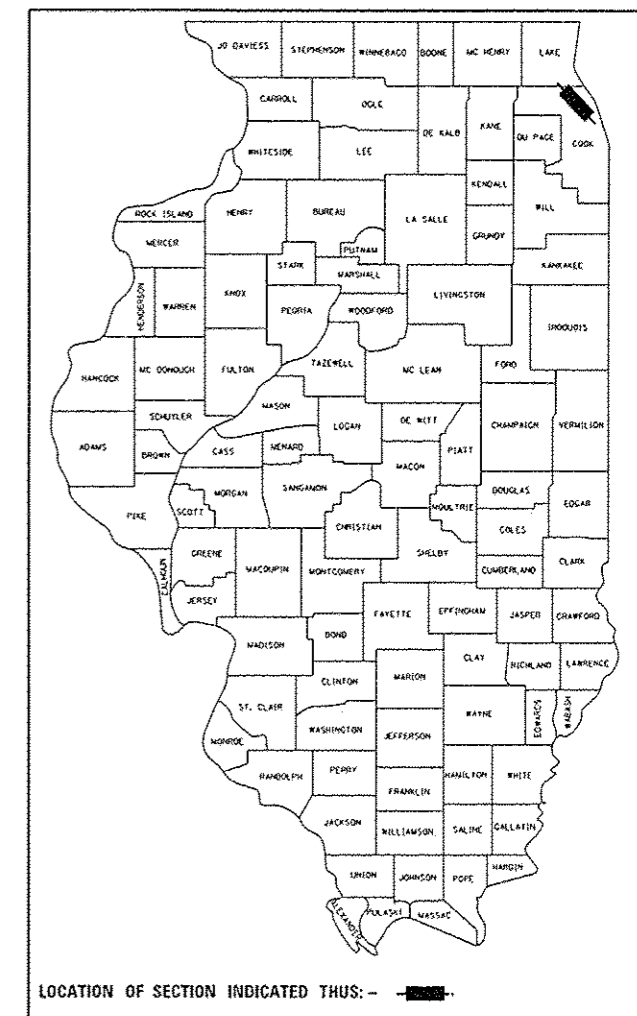

- BEFORE STARTING ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL "J.U.L.I.E." AT (800) 892-0123 FOR FIELD LOCATIONS OF BURIED ELECTRIC, TELEPHONE AND GAS UTILITIES. (48 HOUR NOTIFICATION IS REQUIRED.)
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WITH UTILITY COMPANIES AND THE VILLAGES OF ARLINGTON HEIGHTS AND PALATINE.
- THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON STATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT.
- ALL DAMAGE TO EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING OR RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS OUTSIDE THE REMOVAL LINE SHOWN ON THE PLANS SHALL BE REPLACED AT THE CONTRACTORS EXPENSE.
- WHEN MILLED PAVEMENT IS OPENED TO TRAFFIC THE MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL BETWEEN PASSES OF THE MILLING MACHINE SHALL NOT EXCEED 1 1/2 INCHES WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS 45 MPH OR LESS AND 1 INCH WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS GREATER THAN 45 MPH. WITH WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE ENGINEER, A MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL OF 3 INCHES MAY BE ALLOWED IF THE EDGE OF THE MILLING IS SLOPED A MINIMUM OF 1:3 (V:H).
- BUTT JOINTS WILL BE INSTALLED AT THE ENDS OF ALL RESURFACING (WHERE RESURFACING MEETS EXISTING PAVEMENT), IN ACCORDANCE WITH "BUTT JOINT AND HOT-MIX ASPHALT TAPER DETAILS" SHEET INCLUDED IN THE PLANS, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE DISTRICT ONE TRAFFIC CONTROL SUPERVISOR AT (847) 705-4470 A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF BEGINNING WORK.
- BEFORE BEGINNING WORK, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RETAIN AND RECORD (FOR FUTURE REFERENCES), ALL EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING LINES AND RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS IN ORDER THAT THE LOCATIONS CAN BE RE-ESTABLISHED FOR STRIPING. EXACT LOCATIONS OF ALL STRIPING SHALL BE AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD VERIFY EXISTING DIMENSIONS AND DETAILS AFFECTING NEW CONSTRUCTION OR ORDERING MATERIALS. - LOCATIONS OF COMBINATION CONCRETE CURB AND GUTTER REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT SHALL BE DETERMINED AND/OR VERIFIED IN THE FIELD BY THE ENGINEER.
- LOCATIONS OF CURB RAMP REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT SHALL BE TO THE NEAREST JOINT AND DETERMINED AND/OR VERIFIED IN THE FIELD BY THE ENGINEER.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE ENGINEER REGARDING LOCATION(S) OF DRIVEWAY PAVEMENT TO BE REMOVED AND REPLACED. DRIVEWAY PAVEMENT REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT SHALL BE FULL DEPTH AND THE REPLACED MATERIAL SHALL BE THE SAME AS THE EXISTING. THE COST FOR THIS WORK SHALL BE PAID FOR AS "DRIVEWAY REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT".
- ALL DRIVEWAY REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT LOCATIONS SHALL BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD BY THE ENGINEER.

SIGNING NOTES

- THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE REQUIRED TO TEMPORARILY RESET ALL SUCH SIGNS THAT INTERFERE WITH HIS CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS. ALL SUCH SIGNS SHALL BE MAINTAINED STRAIGHT AND CLEAN FOR THE DURATION OF THE TEMPORARY SETTING AND MUST BE RE-ERECTED AT A TEMPORARY LOCATION IN A WORKMANLIKE MANNER AND BE VISIBLE TO THE TRAFFIC FOR WHICH IT IS INTENDED. THIS WORK WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE UNIT BID PRICES OF THE CONTRACT.
- LONGER POSTS MAY BE REQUIRED AT SOME TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT SIGN LOCATIONS TO MAINTAIN PROPER SIGN ELEVATIONS. THIS WORK SHALL BE COMPLETED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 729 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND INCLUDED IN THE UNIT COST OF THE CONTRACT.

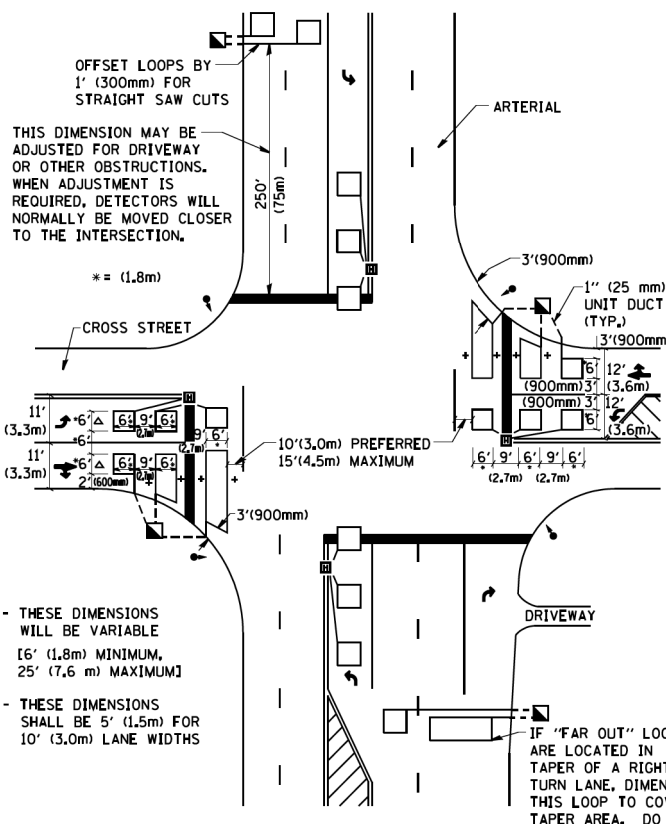

"UPTIGHT" DETECTION REFERS TO NON-LOCKING PRESENCE TYPE DETECTION LOCATED IN ALL LANES AND 10'-15' (3.0 m-4.5 m) BEHIND THE CROSSING STREET'S EDGE OF PAVEMENT EXTENDED.
