Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 68C98, Peoria County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description: This project is approximately 6.1 miles in length along Illinois Route 29. Improvements consist of patching, milling, resurfacing, traffic signal work, guardrail removal and replacement, and other related collateral work necessary to complete the project as shown in the plans. The estimated project cost is \$9.6 million.

Items 4 and 5: The project is a 90-working day contract with an interim completion date of November 30, 2020 to complete patching, milling, binder, and temporary striping. The remainder of the work including HMA surface course, signal work, final pavement markings, and cleanup is anticipated to be done the following construction season.

Item 6: The time required to complete the project extends beyond the expiration of one or more existing collective bargaining agreements covering trades likely to be involved in the project. The trades that will be used on this project include but are not limited to those listed below. Trade contracts expiring prior to the anticipated construction completion date are indicated with bold font.
