## Attachment A

Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 70B38, Champaign County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

**Project Description:** This project is for the reconstruction of the structures carrying Mattis Avenue over FAI 74 and FAI 57. Other improvements associated with the project include sidewalk, paving, roadway lighting, traffic signals, combination concrete curb and gutter, guardrail removal and replacement, earthwork, seeding and mulch, pavement marking, and raised reflective pavement markers.

Item 3: Estimated project cost is \$18,875,000. This project must be completed on schedule for the interchange reconstruction projects to be let. The use of a PLA will assure the project will be completed efficiently.
