#### Attachment A

The use of a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) for Contract 62A76 is consistent with all State and Local statutory and regulatory requirements.

Item 3: This project includes both State and Federal funding and the programmed cost for this project is estimated at \$47,950,000. The scope of work involves the total reconstruction of the Kennedy Expressway(I-90/94) Southbound mainline to 4 through lanes between Roosevelt Road and Lake / Madison Streets in the City of Chicago using continuously reinforced concrete pavement (CRCC) for the mainline lanes and Portland cement concrete jointed pavement (PCC) for the ramps and tapers, construction of one new concrete retaining wall, resurfacing of the transition area at the north end of the expressway reconstruction limit in the SB direction from Ohio Street to the project limits through the Hubbard's Cave, construction of a two-lane collector distributor (C-D) roadway with shoulder within the limits of the project along the west side, replacement of overhead signing within and at the approaches to the project, roadway lighting, ITS upgrades, drainage improvements and the installation of pavement markings. The work also includes special waste clean-up and remediation within the Accident Investigation Site (AIS) at Polk Street and other areas within the project limits in addition to the construction of an underground detention storage facility underneath the AIS near the Cermak Pumping Station. Total length of the project is 1.59 miles.

Item 5: The completion date is November 30, 2022 plus 10 working days for punch list and cleanup items.

Items 6 & 7: There are thirteen different unions that are expected to perform work on this project, some with multiple collective bargaining agreements. As shown in this document, there are many collective bargaining agreements that will expire during completion of the Project. With the high number of different unions expected to be utilized, there is an increased likelihood of jurisdictional disputes among unions or of conflict between unionized and non-unionized workers on the Project.

Item 9: The use of a PLA on this Project will result in improved access to skilled labor, improved efficiency, and improved safety performance due because it will coordinate the labor forces of thirteen separate trade unions on the Project.
