Dear Mr. Myers:

This is in regard to your request for authorization to replace a culvert along IL 250 in Sumner, IL in an unnamed tributary to Shirley Creek, more specifically in the immediate vicinity of 38.7223° N, -87.8621° W. The culvert replacement will include an extension of 10 feet on each end. The culvert will total 51 feet long by 8 feet wide. Rip rap will be placed at the base of the inlet and outlet of the culvert. The information supplied by you was reviewed to determine whether a Department of the Army (DA) permit will be required under the provisions of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

You project is considered a discharge of fill material for bank stabilization activities. The project is authorized under the provisions of 33 CFR 330 B. Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 14, <u>Linear Transportation Projects</u> as published in the Federal Register January 6, 2017. Under the provisions of this authorization you must comply with the enclosed Terms and General Conditions for Nationwide Permit No. 14 and the State 401 Water Quality Certification from the State of Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (ILEPA).

This verification is valid until March 18, 2022. The enclosed Compliance Certification must be submitted to the District Engineer within 30 days of completion of the authorized activity or the implementation of any required compensatory mitigation, whichever occurs later. Note that we also perform periodic inspections to ensure compliance with our permit conditions and applicable Federal laws. A copy of this letter is being sent to your agent and to the ILEPA.
