Peak Hour Restrictions
Short Term and Temporary Pavement Markings
Work Zone Traffic Control Devices
Vehicle and Equipment Warning Lights
Speed Display Trailer
Traffic Spotters

## **PEAK HOUR RESTRICTIONS**

The Contractor shall have all lanes open to traffic during peak hours in each direction along the significant routes as noted in the plans. The Contractor shall not be permitted to conduct any type of operation that would impede the flow of traffic during peak hours. The Contractor shall be permitted to work through the weekends except for those holiday weekends specified in Article 107.09.

Daytime peak hours are defined as:

- Monday through Friday, 6:00 AM to 9:00 AM for southbound I-55, westbound I-64, and westbound I-70.
- Monday through Friday, 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM for northbound I-55, eastbound I-64, and eastbound I-70.

Should the Contractor fail to have all lanes open to traffic during the defined peak hours, the Contractor shall be liable and shall pay to the Department \$1000, not as a penalty but as liquidated damages, for every 15-minute interval or portion thereof that the flow of traffic is impeded by the Contractor's operations. The Department will deduct these liquidated damages from any monies due or to become due to the Contractor from the Department.

## REMOVAL OF LIGHTING LUMINAIRE, NO SALVAGE

<u>Description</u>. This work shall consist of removing the existing roadway luminaires and underpass luminaires in accordance with applicable portions of Section 842 of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as indicated on the plans and as directed by the Engineer. The luminaire shall include all appurtenances that comprise the complete operating unit.

<u>Removal</u>. The existing roadway luminaire shall not be salvaged and shall be removed and disposed of from the site at the Contractor's expense.

Basis of Payment. This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per EACH for REMOVAL OF LIGHTING LUMINAIRE. NO SALVAGE.
