COOK COUNTY HIGHWAY PERMIT

The Contractor will be required to obtain a permit from the Cook County Highway Department to construct the traffic signal detectors at the intersection of Lakewood Boulevard Sauk Trail as shown on sheet 7 of the plan set. The Contractor shall execute all necessary Cook County Highway Department permit forms, provide and pay for any fee and bond requirements, and execute and comply with all insurance and performance guarantee requirements as included to the Detector Loop, Type 1 work. No work may be performed within the County Right of Way until a signed permit is issued.
