- EXCEPT WHERE DESIGNATED OTHERWISE, THE LOCATIONS AND/OR DEPTHS OF UNDERGROUND UTILITIES SHOWN HAVE BEEN TAKEN FROM OFFICE RECORD INFORMATION FURNISHED BY THE UTILITY OWNERS AND MUST BE CONSIDERED APPROXIMATE.

- (5) THE THICKNESS OF THE BITUMINOUS MIXTURE SHOWN ON THE PLANS IS THE NOMINAL THICKNESS. DEVIATIONS FROM THE NOMINAL THICKNESS WILL BE PERMITTED WHEN SUCH DEVIATIONS OCCUR DUE TO IRREGULARITIES IN THE EXISTING SURFACE OR BASE ON WHICH THE BITUMINOUS MIXTURE IS PLACED.

- (10) ROAD CONSTRUCTION AHEAD SIGNS SHALL BE PLACED AT THE BEGINNING AND END OF THE PROJECT PLUS THE INTERSECTING SIDE ROADS, AND WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PAY ITEMS. ALL CONSTRUCTION SIGNS SHALL BE FLUORESCENT ORANGE.
- (11) FLAGMEN SHALL BE PRESENT DURING ALL CLOSURE HOURS, INCLUDING LUNCH HOUR, AND NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION SHALL BE APPLIED.
- (12) ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES SHALL BE SKID MOUNTED
- (13) EXCAVATION ADJACENT TO EDGE OF PAVEMENT SHALL BE PROTECTED WITH EXTENDED LEG BARRICADES WITH APPROPRIATE LIGHTS.
- (14) ANY SIGNS DISTURBED DURING CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE PROTECTED AND RESTORED ACCORDING TO ARTICLE 107.25 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- (15) THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND ORDERING OF MATERIALS.
- (16) ALL SAW CUTTING FOR REMOVAL ITEMS SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF THE REMOVAL ITEM. ALL SAWCUTS SHALL BE FULL DEPTH IN ORDER TO PREVENT DAMAGE TO THE PAVEMENT REMAINING IN PLACE. THIS COST IS INCLUDED IN THE REMOVAL ITEM.
- (17) AREAS PAID FOR AS "PAVEMENT REMOVAL" SHALL INCLUDE THE REMOVAL OF CURB AND GUTTER. AGGREGATE, AND ANY OTHER MATERIALS WITHIN THE REMOVAL LIMITS SHOWN IN THE PLANS. NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION SHALL BE ALLOWED.
- (18) AN ESTIMATED 90 TONS OF BITUMINOUS SURFACE WILL BE REMOVED DURING MILLING
- (19) ALL NUTRIENTS REQUIRED FOR "SEEDING, CLASS 24" SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF "SEEDING. CLASS 2A" AND NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION SHALL BE ALLOWED.
- (2) IF AT ANY POINT DURING THE MILLING OPERATION THE CONCRETE BASE IS ENCOUNTERED, THE MILLING DEPTH SHALL BE REDUCED SO THAT THE CONCRETE BASE IS NOT DISTURBED.
- (2) IF THE MILLING OPERATION DOES NOT REMOVE ALL CONFLICTING EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING, THE REQUIRED REMOVAL SHALL BE PAID FOR AS "WORK ZONE PAVEMENT MARKING REMOVAL". AN ADDITIONAL 80 SQ. FT. HAS BEEN INCLUDED IN THE PLANS.
