

5. AERIAL CABLE AND TEMPORARY WOOD POLES SHALL BE REMOVED AFTER HIGH MAST LIGHT TOWERS ARE PERMANENTLY WIRED AND ACCEPTED BY THE ENGINEER.

6. TEMPORARY WOOD POLES SHALL BE INSERTED IN GROUND TO ACCOMMODATE PROPOSED GRADING.
