- _⊠_ 6) The time required to complete the Project is expected to extend beyond the expiration date of one or more existing collective bargaining agreements covering trades likely to be involved in the Project, thereby increasing the likelihood of work stoppage(s) or other labor disruption(s) during construction of the Project.
- _⊠_ 7) In the absence of a PLA, there is an increased likelihood of jurisdictional disputes among unions or of conflict between unionized and non-unionized workers on the Project that could have a potentially material adverse effect on the time, cost, or quality of work performed on the Project.

The scope of work consists of complete replacement of water main facilities from 159th St to 138th St; roadway reconstruction from 149th St to 144th St, including the railroad crossings between 147th St (IL – Sibley Boulevard) and 144th St; sidewalk and shared-use path construction; traffic signal modernization; drainage improvement; roadway lighting; and aesthetic landscaping.
