- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WITH UTILITY
  COMPANIES
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON STATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT.
- 4. WHEN ARTIFICIAL LIGHTING IS USED IN NIGHT OPERATIONS THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXERCISE THE UTMOST PRECAUTIONS IN PREVENTING ADVERSE VISIBILTY TO THE MOTORING PUBLIC AND ADJOINING RESIDENTIAL AREAS.
- 1. 5. WHEN MILLED PAVEMENT IS OPEN TO TRAFFIC THE MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL BETWEEN PASSES OF THE MILLING MACHINE SHALL NOT EXCEED 1 1/2 INCHES (40 MM) WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS 45 MPH (80 KM/H) OR LESS AND 1 INCH (25 MM) WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS GREATER THAN 45 MPH (80 KM/H).
