Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 68503, Henderson County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description:

This project is located on Carman Road from 0.5 mile north of 750N to Illinois Route 96 from east of Carman Road to west of Benton Street in Lomax in Henderson County. This project consists of resurfacing, guardrail replacement, and all other related collateral work necessary to complete the project along Carman Road and Illinois Route 96 in Henderson County.

The estimated project cost is \$3.9 million.

Item 4: The project is to be completed in 75 working days with an interim completion date of November 15, 2021 for all work except permanent pavement markings, punch list items, and cleanup. The interim completion date is based on an aggressive schedule. Any delays due to labor disputes would likely push the completion of the resurfacing, shoulders and temporary pavement marking work into the next construction season.
