Item 3: This project includes both State and Federal funding and the programmed cost for this project is estimated at \$7,367,000. Scope of work for the project includes ADA sidewalk improvement, pavement patching, hot-mix asphalt surface removal, resurfacing with polymerized HMA surface course, detector loop replacement, relocating existing pedestrian push buttons, curb and gutter replacement, thermoplastic pavement marking, raised reflective pavement markers, sidewalk removal and replacement.
