Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 74779 Macon County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description: This project is for the rehabilitation of FAP 322A from US 51 Bus. SW of Decatur to 0.5 mi North of Shelby County line. Other improvements associated with the project include paving, patching, milling, traffic control and pavement marking.
